YOU CAN:

- 3. Place a small advertisement in the window of eg. your local newsagent/shop/pub/post office** about the Campaign Against Political Correctness and we will do the rest.
- 4. Let us know about politically correct activity in your area** (even if you can only do so on a confidential basis) enabling us to show others that they are not alone in their experiences.
- 5. Write to your local newspapers and phone your local radio stations** to complain about politically correct activities and stories in your area.

You can help by objecting to political correctness whenever you experience it first hand.

It is worth bearing in mind that people you know who use politically correct words or actions are not necessarily doing so because they believe it is right – they may just think they have to – and if you explain how divisive and unhelpful political correctness really is, you may find they are actually grateful to you for confirming what they may have already thought themselves but not felt able to express openly.
